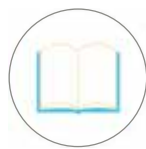

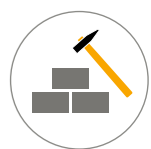

(Initial and follow-up approvals, projects and accompanying measures worldwide in 2025)

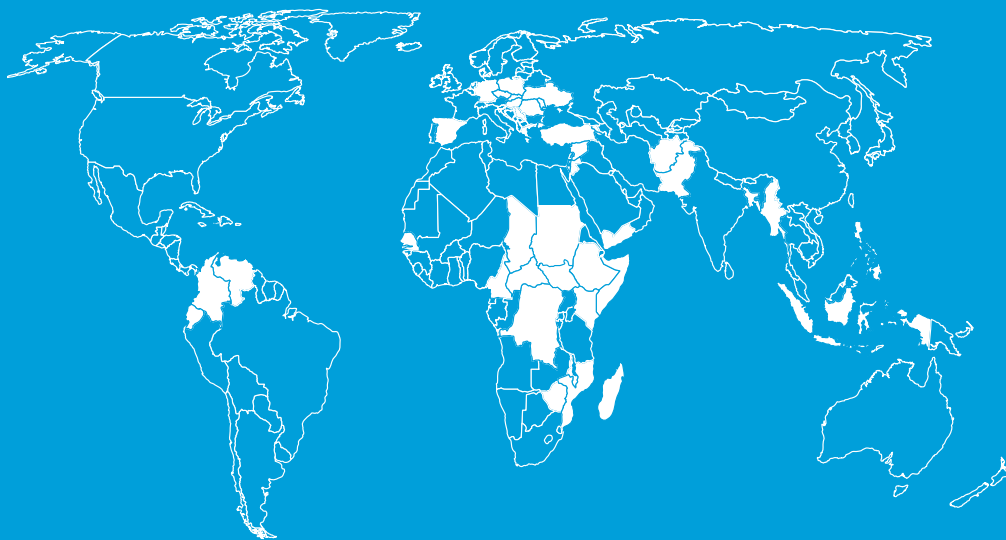
